

Notice of Public Hearing of the Hays Trinity Groundwater Conservation District Board of Directors August 6, 2020

An urgent public necessity exists requiring the District to alter our meeting procedures due to COVID-19 pandemic. Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the Hays Trinity Groundwater Conservation District will hold a regular public meeting via telephone conference call pursuant to Texas Government Code, Section 551.125, and as modified by the Governor of Texas who ordered suspension of various provisions of the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Government Code, effective March 16, 2020, in accordance with the Texas Disaster Act of 1975 (see the Governor's proclamation on March 13, 2020, certifying that the COVID-19 pandemic poses an imminent threat of disaster and declaring a state of disaster for all counties in Texas).

 - Procedure, Conduct and Decorum at Meetings of the Board of Directors

The HTGCD Board of Directors shall review and discuss the permit amendment application, hear staff recommendations, and hear the application without motion or action. If a formal protest is timely filed before June 3, 2020, the application shall be found contested and the Board shall: close the Hearing, declare application Contested, and move to open a Pre-Hearing Conference. If the amendment application is not formally contested, the HTGCD Board may take action on the amendment application. The applicant may contest the Board's action by filing a formal contested case letter within ten days after the Board's action. The applicant is considered to have Standing and shall be heard at an Evidentiary Hearing.

Pre Hearing Conference:

The Pre-Hearing Conference shall take place immediately following the permit amendment application Hearing and only applies to non-applicants to determine Standing. The HTGCD Board of Directors shall hear those who are contesting and determine if they have Standing (District Rule 5.5). For those with Standing, the Board may:

- a. Recommend a Continuance and allow parties to resolve the amendment application amongst themselves and report back to the HTGCD within 30 days; or
- b. The parties schedule an Evidentiary Hearing with a Hearing examiner; or

c. Upon the request of the applicant or protestant, the Board may delegate to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH)

EXECUTIVE SESSION

The Board of Directors of the Hays Trinity Conservation District reserves the right to adjourn into Executive Session at any time during the course of this meeting to discuss any of the posted matters listed on this agenda, as authorized by the Texas Government Code Chapter 551 including Section 551.071 (Consultation with Attorney) and Section 551.074 (Personnel Matters). No final action or decision will be made in Executive Session.
