

## The Watershed Association's Art4Water Program Sacred Springs Kite Exhibition

A non-profit organization located in the heart of the Texas Hill Country, born out of a love for water.

For over two decades, the Watershed Association has played a crucial role in the Texas Hill Country through land and water protection, scientific research and monitoring, public policy advocacy, land stewardship and restoration, environmental education, and watershed planning. What started with the establishment of the Jacob's Well Natural Area and conserving over 500 acres of land around the iconic spring, has now grown to include regional conservation initiatives and a collective impact through the engagement of hundreds of network partners. Today, the Watershed Association is at the center of a regenerative conservation movement in the fastest growing region in the United States.

Our Texas springs are threatened and many are drying up under the twin threats of climate change and over-pumping aquifers to serve the bursting demands of population growth. The current period of prolonged drought has depleted many reservoir levels to historic lows bringing an increased reliance on groundwater to keep up with the demand. Increased development also threatens our water quality, already making some areas unswimmable and undrinkable. Our historical work at the Watershed Association has never been more imperative.

Your support of the Sacred Springs Kite Exhibition helps to support our work to ensure clean and plentiful water continues to flow through our beautiful and fragile region.

While we have been protecting Texas land and water for over 25 years through shaping public policy, land and water stewardship, education, and conservation, this year we are celebrating a new era of advocacy that includes the language of expression, through the **Art4Water Program**.
